Absentee In-House Voting Available for Registered Voters Who Qualify

(Louisville, KY) Jefferson County Clerk Bobbie Holsclaw has released dates for registered voters in Jefferson County who will be absent from the county on November 8, 2016 for the General Election. Voters can cast their ballot at the Election Center September 26th through November 7th. Kentucky law allows people to vote in-house prior to Election Day for the following reasons:

- 1. Voter who will be outside the county on Election Day.
- 2. Student who temporarily resides outside the county in which he/she is registered and will be out of the county on Election Day.
- 3. Voter who is a member of the Armed Forces or a dependent of a member of the Armed Forces and who will be out of the county on Election Day.
- 4. Voter who is a member of the Armed Forces who will be confined to base within the county on Election Day and who learns of that confinement within 7 days or less of the election.
- 5. Voter who is a citizen residing overseas and will be out of the county on Election Day.
- 6. Voter or spouse of voter who has surgery scheduled that will require hospitalization on Election Day.
- 7. Precinct Election Officer serving in a precinct other than that in which he/she is registered or an Alternate Precinct Election Officer.
- 8. Member or any staff for the County Board of Elections; any deputy county clerk; any staff for the State Board of Elections.
- 9. PRESIDENTIAL BALLOT ONLY: Moved to another state after its registration books closed.

 10. A woman in her last trimester of pregnancy.
- 11. KRS 117.088 Pilot program for unassisted voting by blind and visually impaired persons.
