C134 Option Election to be Held June 21st

(Louisville, KY) In accordance with KRS 242.020 a petition has been filed calling for a local option (wet/dry) election regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages in Precinct C134. According to Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk and Chairperson of the Board of Elections, "The verification and approval of the petition being correctly filed and the petition containing a sufficient number of valid signatures of registered voters has been made by the Board of Elections."

By executive order the local option election shall be held in Precinct C134 on June 21, 2016, . Voting will take place at Buechel Firehouse and the polling location will be open from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM. In- house voting will begin on May 3rd through June 20th from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM at the Election Center located in the Urban Government Center at 810 Barret Avenue. Wet – A county that allows sales of alcoholic beverages for on-site or off-site consumption in areas outside an incorporated city.

 $\underline{\mathbf{Dry}}$ – A territory has voted for prohibition, therefore prohibiting all sales of alcoholic beverages with no exceptions. Prohibition means the application KRS 242.190-242.430 to that territory. KRS 242.010(33)

<u>**Dry Territory**</u> – A county, city, or district or precinct tin which a majority of voters have voted in favor of prohibition. KRS 241.010(21)

Part Dry Precinct – These do exist because they have been altered as a result of redistricting.
