Kentucky Senate 38th District Special Election Date Set

Election Scheduled for Tuesday, January 14th

(Louisville, KY) In accordance with KRS 118.730 and 118.740, a writ of election has been issued to fill a vacancy occurring in the Kentucky Senate. Senator Dan Seum of the 38th District resigned from the General Assembly, effective November 16, 2019. The special election, to be held on Tuesday, January 14, will be to fill the vacancy in the 38th Senatorial District. The 38th Senatorial District is comprised of part of Jefferson County and all of Bullitt County. Polls will be open 6 am to 6 pm.

Due to the nature of this race, only the 38th District will be voting. Registered voters can check to see if their address is in the 38th Senatorial District by visiting <http://jeffersoncountyclerk.org/wheredoivote/>

Also, because schools are open on the day of the special election, the following precincts will be **temporarily** moved:

Bates Elementary (B134; B158; B175) will vote in Living Hope Baptist Church - 10205 Bardstown Bluff Rd

Blue Lick Elementary (I141; I145) will vote in St. Luke Catholic Church - 4211 Jim Hawkins Dr

Wilt Elementary (I153; I154) will vote in Amvets Post #61 - 9405 Smyrna Pkwy

Fairdale High School (I133) will vote in Fairdale Playtorium – 10616 W Manslick Rd
