7 Locations Across Jefferson County Will Serve as In-Person No-Excuse Absentee Polling Locations Prior to General Election Day

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (08/23/2022): Following the approval of the Jefferson County Board of Elections and in compliance with the latest state legislation, Jefferson County Clerk and Chairperson, Board of Elections Bobbie Holsclaw today shared how voters can choose to make their voice heard and participate in the secure voting process for the General Election in 2022.

"Our office improved access to the ballot box during the Primary Election while ensuring the integrity and security of the election process, which translated into increased voter participation," said Jefferson County Clerk Bobbie Holsclaw "We are glad to again offer the same conveniences for the General Election so that all qualified voters in Jefferson County can have a stake in the future of their communities."

Jefferson County citizens can cast their General Election vote in one of the following ways:

In-Person No-Excuse Absentee (Early) Voting

DAYS: Thursday, November 3; Friday, November 4; Saturday, November 5 TIME: 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

The absentee ballot tab will not be available until forty-five (45) days before the date of the General Election and closes fourteen (14) days preceding the General Election.
