With A Two-Sided Ballot, Voter Preparation Is More Important Than Ever

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (10/25/2022): With competitive races and constitutional amendments to be decided when polls close at 6 p.m. Nov. 8, voters across the community will receive a ballot with voting choices printed on two sides. Jefferson County Clerk Bobbie Holsclaw is reminding voters to check both sides of their ballot to make sure they do not miss any options, and that they can do so before voting by viewing their easily accessible sample ballot on the Clerk's Office election website prior to heading to the polls or receiving their mail-in ballots.

"Voting is a cherished American right, but with that right comes responsibilities. Among those responsibilities is the need to be as informed as possible, since your choices make an impact on your future," said Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk. "Viewing your sample ballot online is one way to ensure that you are as prepared as possible, and know which candidates could represent you and how the Kentucky constitution could change."

Voters can visit <u>elections.jeffersoncountyclerk.org/MyBallot</u> and securely enter their street address to view their sample ballot. The Jefferson County Clerk's Office does not store any addresses entered or other information about voters entered on the site.

Because of the length of the ballot, voters may experience some wait times when going to the polls to vote. All Election Day voters in line by 6 p.m. will be allowed to cast ballots. To minimize the likelihood of a wait and to have your vote cast before Nov. 8, voters are encouraged to participate during the in-person no-excuse absentee (early) voting period, and can find a list of locations at elections.jeffersoncountyclerk.org/inhouse absentee
